# A Rain Garden

Making a beautiful difference for Children Unlimited

## What is a Rain Garden?

The garden that you see is just one example of a rain garden. It is a special area of the lawn (or other open space) that captures runoff from roofs, parking lots, sidewalks, and other paved areas. The purpose is to absorb the rain water so it doesn't run off into the street or storm drain. This helps to reduce the amount of water that enters the storm drain system, which can help to reduce the amount of water that enters the storm drain system.

## How does a Rain Garden work?

The rain garden works by using plants and soil to absorb the water. The plants have roots that go down into the soil, and the soil has small spaces that hold the water. The water then slowly soaks into the ground, where it can be used by the plants and the soil.






