

#### SETTING THE DATE AND TIME

- 1. Turn the dial to the "Date/Time" position.
- 2. Press the "Date/Time" button.
- 3. Use the arrow buttons to set the date and time.
- 4. Press the "Date/Time" button again to save the settings.

#### SETTING PROGRAM RUN TIMES

- 1. Turn the dial to the "Run Times" position.
- 2. Press the "Run Times" button.
- 3. Use the arrow buttons to set the run times for each zone.
- 4. Press the "Run Times" button again to save the settings.

#### SETTING ZONE RUN TIMES

- 1. Turn the dial to the "Zone Run Times" position.
- 2. Press the "Zone Run Times" button.
- 3. Use the arrow buttons to set the run times for each zone.
- 4. Press the "Zone Run Times" button again to save the settings.

#### SETTING DAYS TO WATER

- 1. Turn the dial to the "Days to Water" position.
- 2. Press the "Days to Water" button.
- 3. Use the arrow buttons to select the days you want to water.
- 4. Press the "Days to Water" button again to save the settings.

#### SELECTING SPECIFIC DAYS OF THE WEEK TO WATER

- 1. Turn the dial to the "Specific Days" position.
- 2. Press the "Specific Days" button.
- 3. Use the arrow buttons to select the specific days you want to water.
- 4. Press the "Specific Days" button again to save the settings.

#### RAIN SENSOR OFF/ON SWITCH

- 1. Turn the dial to the "Rain Sensor" position.
- 2. Press the "Rain Sensor" button.
- 3. Use the arrow buttons to turn the rain sensor on or off.
- 4. Press the "Rain Sensor" button again to save the settings.

#### SEASONAL ADJUSTMENT

- 1. Turn the dial to the "Seasonal Adjust" position.
- 2. Press the "Seasonal Adjust" button.
- 3. Use the arrow buttons to select the seasonal adjustment.
- 4. Press the "Seasonal Adjust" button again to save the settings.

#### SMART CONTROLLER'S MEMORY/RESETTING CONTROLLER

- 1. Turn the dial to the "Memory/Reset" position.
- 2. Press the "Memory/Reset" button.
- 3. Use the arrow buttons to select the memory/reset option.
- 4. Press the "Memory/Reset" button again to save the settings.

#### MANUALLY OPERATING A SINGLE ZONE

- 1. Turn the dial to the "Manual" position.
- 2. Press the "Manual" button.
- 3. Use the arrow buttons to select the zone you want to water.
- 4. Press the "Manual" button again to start watering.

#### SMART SYSTEM EXPANSE

- 1. Turn the dial to the "Smart System Expansive" position.
- 2. Press the "Smart System Expansive" button.
- 3. Use the arrow buttons to select the smart system expansive option.
- 4. Press the "Smart System Expansive" button again to save the settings.


